Step One: WRITTEN APPLICATION	
Read, sign and submit to RIU your application of membership to The River Academic eXchange (TRAX).	June 15 December 15

Completely answer, sign and submit to RIU the Statement of Purpose form.	June 15 December 15
Read, sign and submit to RIU the Student Privacy Right form.	June 15 or December 15
Step Two: RECOMMENDATIONS	
Each applicant must solicit three recommendations: the first is from a ministry leader from the "home" church. It can be from a pastor, elder, deacon, staff or ministry department leader. The second and third recommendations are from people who know the applicant well and can speak on his/her behalf regarding character, gifts, and calling. Please, refrain from using relatives. These recommendations are to be returned to RIU by the one who filled out the form, not the applicant.	June 15 December 15
Step Three: TRANSCRIPTS ORDERED	
Request transcripts to high school or diploma issuing agencies AND/OR other higher learning institutions. They must be received by RIU no later than 2 weeks prior to registration day. Order now so the schools can send before the due date.	June 15 December 15
Step Four: ACCEPTANCE/DENIAL LETTER	
Applicants will receive a notification of acceptance or denial for the following term via email. Acceptance letter must be received before the next steps.	January 1 July 1
Step Five: ACADEMIC ADVISORY MEETING	
Each student will be connected with an academic advisor to "map out" the Discipline/Courses. This one-on-one meeting happens every term with all students and advisors to keep track of progress.	January 30 June 30

PRIVACY RIGHTS OF STUDENTS

STATUTE 20, United States Code, Section 1232g and regulations adopted pursuant thereto, hereafter, referred to as the Code, requires that each student be notified of the rights accorded him or her by the Code. The following is provided as basic general information relative to the Code:

The Code provides for the institution to establish a category of student information termed "directory information". When available in college records, any information falling in the category of "directory information" will be available to all persons on request, i.e., the IRS, FBI or other government agencies and for use in RIU publications. RIU has identified the following as "directory information".

Student's:

- 1. Name
- 2. Address
- 3. Telephone Listing
- 4. Date and Place of Birth
- 5. Discipline
- 6. Church Membership
- 7. Denominational Affiliation
- 8. Dates of Attendance
- 9. Degrees and Awards Received
- 10. Most Recent Previous Educational
- 11. Agency or Institution Attended

All other information, such as health and medical records, disciplinary records, records of personal counseling, required student and family financial income records, transcripts of student permanent academic records, student placement records and other personally identifiable information shall be open for inspection only to the student and such members of the professional staff of the school that have responsibility for working with the student. Such information will not be released to second parties without consent of the student.

Except as required for use in the discharge of official institutional responsibilities, the designated custodian of such records may release information from these records to others only upon authorization in writing from the student or upon a subpoena by a court of competent jurisdiction.

TRANSCRIPT REQUEST PROCEDURE



A high school or equivalent diploma is required of each applicant to enroll at River Impact University. It is imperative that applicants request transcripts as soon as possible from the high school's registrar's office or diploma-issuing agency. Transcripts must reach the River Impact University's Office of Student Administrative Services by 2 weeks before registration. The institutions will need the following information when you call:

- 1. Your full legal and/or maiden name
- 2. The years in attendance to that educational institution
- 3. RIU's mailing or email address:

If an applicant has taken Biblical courses from an accredited institution of higher education and applicant desires to transfer up to 30 credits to RIU, the applicant must request this official transcript in addition to the high school transcript and submit to RIU's review. Upon approval, the applicant will be consulted and made aware which courses can and can not be applied to applicant's credit. Also, note that some institutions may charge a fee for this service.
